ASSEMBLY/USER INSTRUCTIONS

Forearm Crutches come fully assembled.

Forearm Crutches are used for partial weight bearing to help you balance or redistribute the load placed on your legs while you walk.

These crutches have two adjustments, one for the distance between the cuff and the handgrip and one for the shaft length.

Before making any tubing length adjustments loosen the threaded tightening ring (A) (if there is one, some models do not have a threaded tightening ring) on the crutch shaft.

When adjusting the length of the shaft tubing, be sure the push button (B) fully protrudes through the adjustment hole of the shaft to ensure a positive lock. Once you have the desired height tighten the threaded locking ring.



Do not hang bags on the handle of your crutch.

Before use, check to make sure that rubber tips are not ripped, worn, or missing. Replace if necessary before use.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS


Clean with mild, non-abrasive cleanser and water, dry thoroughly.
